NOTIFICATION

No. A.12018/47/2004-P&AR(GSW), the 25th February, 2011. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Retail Store Keeper, Store Keeper, Generator Operator and Carpenter under Printing & Stationery Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short Title and (1)These Rules may be called the Govt. of Mizoram, Printing & Stationery Department (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2011. Commencement (2)They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. 2. Application These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules. 3. Number of posts, The number of the said posts, their classification, Pay Band and classification, pay band Grade pay/pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 and grade pay/pay scale to 4 of the said Schedule. 4. Method of recruitment, The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters age limit, relating to the posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the qualifications etc.aforesaid Schedule. Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram from time to time. 5. Disqualification No person-(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

		(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.
		Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of this rule.
6.	Training and Departmental Examination.	Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7.	Powers to transfer	Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8.	Powers to relax	Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9.	Reservation and other	Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10.	Repeal and Savings	All rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Notification No. A. 12018/8(i)/8-APT (B) dated 26.5.1982 and Notification No. A. 12018/8/81-APT (B) dated 3.10.1991 Issue No. 152 dated 7.10.1991 stand hereby repealed on and from the commencement of these rules.
		Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general order

ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
