NOTIFICATION

No. A.12018/10/2003-P&AR(GSW), the 1st February, 2011. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the post(s) of Cartographer, under Land Revenue and Settlement Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

1. *Short Title and Commencement*
 - (1) These Rules may be called the Govt. of Mizoram, Land Revenue and Settlement Department (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2010.
 - (2) It shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. *Application*

These rules shall apply to the post(s) specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. *Number of posts, classification, and Scale of Pay*

The number of the said post(s), their classification Pay Band and Grade pay/pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
4. *Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.-*

The age limit, qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.
5. *Disqualification*

No person-

 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

6. *Training and Departmental Examination.* Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. *Powers to transfer and Posting* Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these rules to any other post or position in any Department which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. *Power to relax* Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9. *Reservation and other concessions* Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10. *Repeal & Savings* All rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Gazetted Notification No. A. 12018/39/80-APT (B) dt 14.6.1985 Issue No. 23 dt. 14.6.1985 and No. A. 12018/39/80-APT(B) Vol-I dt. 17.9.1997 Issue No. 329 dt. 25.9.1997 for the post of Cartographer-II & III stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed, or under any general order ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
