NOTIFICATION

No.A-32012/1/2011-P&AR(GSW) Aizawl, the 28th July, 2023: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules to amend the recruitment rules/service rules under the Government of Mizoram, namely;

1. *Short title and commencement.* -
 - (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Recruitment/Service (Amendment) Rules, 2023.
 - (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. *Application.* -

These rules shall be applicable to all the recruitment rules/service rules of Group 'A', 'B', 'C', and 'D' under the Government of Mizoram.
3. *Amendment of recruitment rules.* -

In all recruitment rules as specified in rule 2 of these rules, the following note shall be inserted below the Table in Schedule-II (Methods of recruitment, field of selection and eligibility criteria) of the recruitment rules where promotion is the mode of recruitment;

"Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed the probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service."

4. *Amendment of
service rules.-*

In all service rules as specified in rule 2 of these rules, the following note shall be inserted below the Table in Schedule-II (Methods of recruitment, field of selection and eligibility criteria) of the recruitment rules where promotion is the mode of recruitment;

“Note: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed the probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.”
